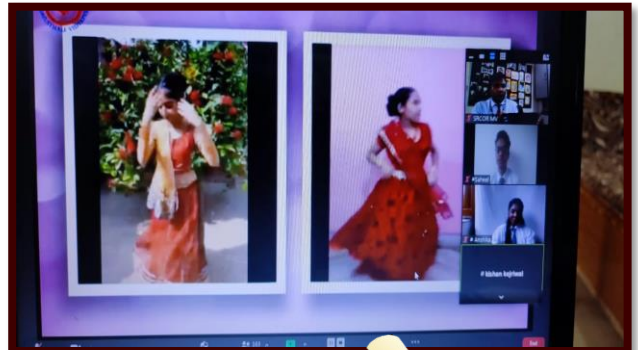
ANNUAL FOUNDATION DAY 7TH July 2021

Inter – House Debate 31st July 2021

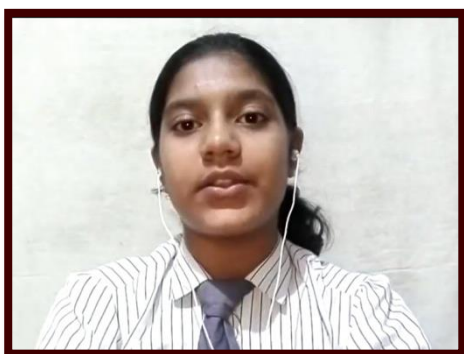
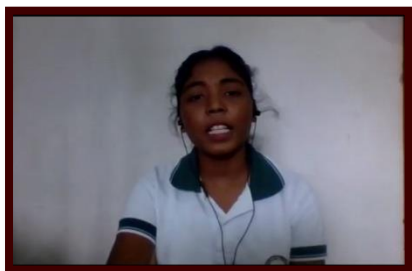

Hindi Diwas 14th August 2021

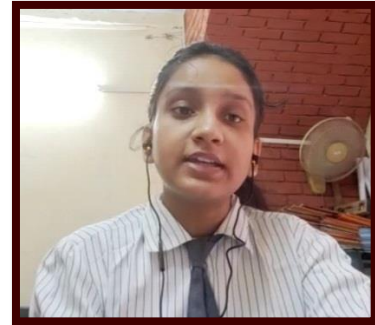
Hindi Diwas is celebrated on September 14 to pay tribute to the official language of India.

Online Junior Section English Recitation Competition stole the show on 21st August 2021.

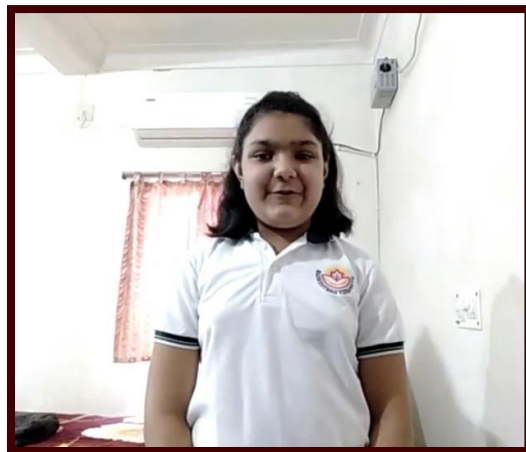
Altogether, 24 participants from Std. 3 to 5 took the virtual platform to recite under the themes - Rainbow, Family and Season.

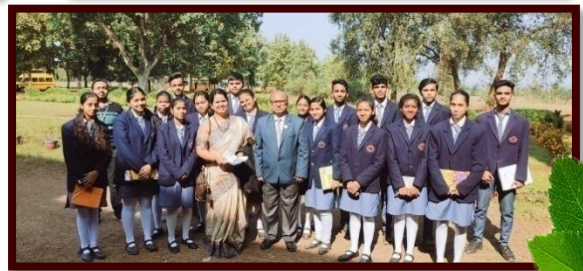


Teachers & Students workshop

Kiddies Day Out Back to School

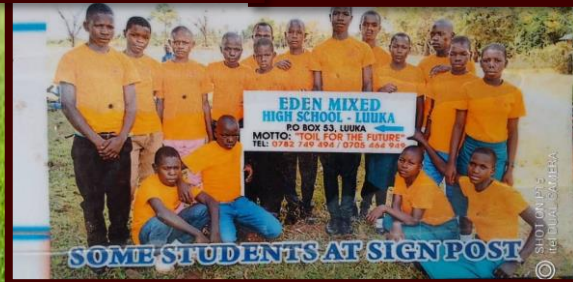
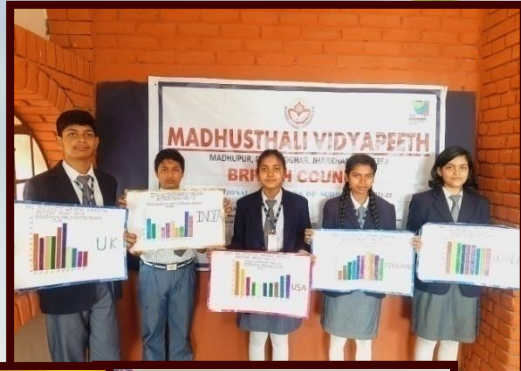
