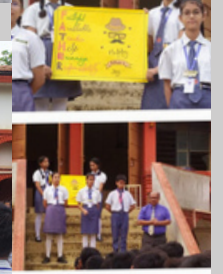
Father's day

21 JUNE, 2023

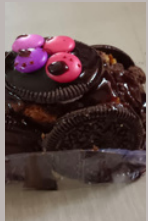
