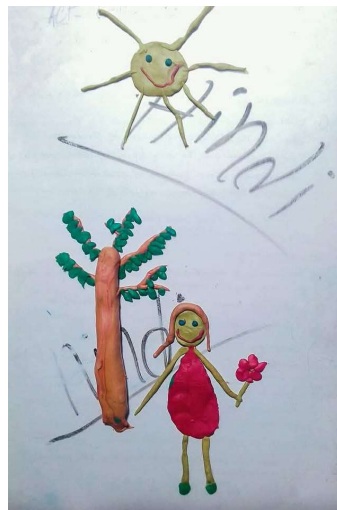
## Re-view: The Pages
