CISCE'S Regional Shooting and Archery Competition 2025

Madhusthali Vidyapeeth proudly hosted the first CISCE Regional Archery and Shooting Championships for Bihar and Jharkhand on 25th July 2025. The opening ceremony was graced by the Principal, Headmaster, Dean of Activities, coordinators, visiting coaches, teachers, and participants. Students aged 14–19 from CISCE schools across the region showcased their skills in a highly competitive event. Madhusthali Vidyapeeth excelled, winning 27 medals in Shooting and 20 in Archery, securing qualification for the CISCE Nationals. Jamshedpur Zone led in Archery, followed by Deoghar and Bhagalpur Zones. Winners were felicitated with medals and certificates, while officials and escort teachers received appreciation certificates. With this success, our students will now represent the region at the CISCE National Archery Championship in Kerala and the Shooting Championship in Karnataka later this year.

The teaching and administrative staff attended an enriching session conducted by Ms. Priya Bharti on the theme From Soil to Soul – A Reflection on TFN. The session highlighted the values of the Teach for Nature programme, encouraging a shift from human-centered to nature-centered thinking. Through real-life stories, hands-on activities and engaging discussions, participants reflected on how education can connect learners with the environment, nurture empathy, and promote sustainability in classrooms. The session inspired all to reimagine their teaching roles as facilitators of environmental awareness and advocates of a greener future. It was a meaningful experience that left everyone motivated to bring small but impactful changes in their everyday teaching practices.



Workshop on Nature Integration



A two-day workshop on the Nature-Integrated Curriculum was held on 19th–20th July 2025 at the College Auditorium, facilitated by Ms. Rajlaxmi Dash (MCKV) and Ms. Priya Bharti (MV). The program was inaugurated by our Principal, with a debriefing by the Education Officer outlining its objectives.

Day 1 Highlights

The facilitators shared insights from their three-month residential program at Bhoomi College, Bangalore. Discussions focused on Inquiry-Based and Active Learning methodologies, emphasizing:

- * Building student connections with nature in daily life.
- * Blending academics with outdoor experiential learning.
- * Moving from teacher-led to student-led classrooms.
- * Shifting from object-based to process-oriented thinking.
- * Fostering creativity, collaboration, and problem-solving.

Day 2 Highlights

Day 2 explored Gaia Principles and Place-Based Learning (PBL). The Gaia Hypothesis set the tone for understanding Earth as a living entity, reinforced through the Web of Life activity. PBL discussions highlighted:

- * Cultivating responsibility and awareness of local environments.
- * Providing real-world, experiential learning beyond textbooks.
- * Developing strong personal connections with one's place.
- * Fostering belonging to both classroom and community.

Parents Teacher Meeting Conducted for Class X



The Class 10 Parents-Teachers Meeting was attended by 45 parents along with their wards and was led by the Principal, Headmaster, and Education Officer. The session focused on student performance, strategies for improvement, and board exam preparation. Subject teachers and the coordinator shared individual progress, highlighting strengths and areas for improvement, while suggesting regular monitoring, consistent study habits, and open communication with teachers. The Education Officer delivered an insightful presentation on the differences between CBSE and ICSE. CBSE emphasizes conceptual understanding, competency-based learning, and flexibility, while ICSE offers a comprehensive syllabus, stronger focus on language skills, and a more rigorous assessment pattern. Parents were advised on how ICSE provides holistic education, better language proficiency, and critical thinking skills, making it a strong option for students. The meeting included an interactive Q&A session, encouraging parents to support their children's progress, while students were urged to stay disciplined and adopt a positive approach to learning. The session concluded with a reminder of the importance of parent-teacher collaboration in ensuring academic success. Sincere thanks to the Education Officer, Principal, Headmaster, coordinators, teachers, parents, and students for making the session meaningful and productive.

Annual Plantation Drive 2025

28th Annual Day Celebration



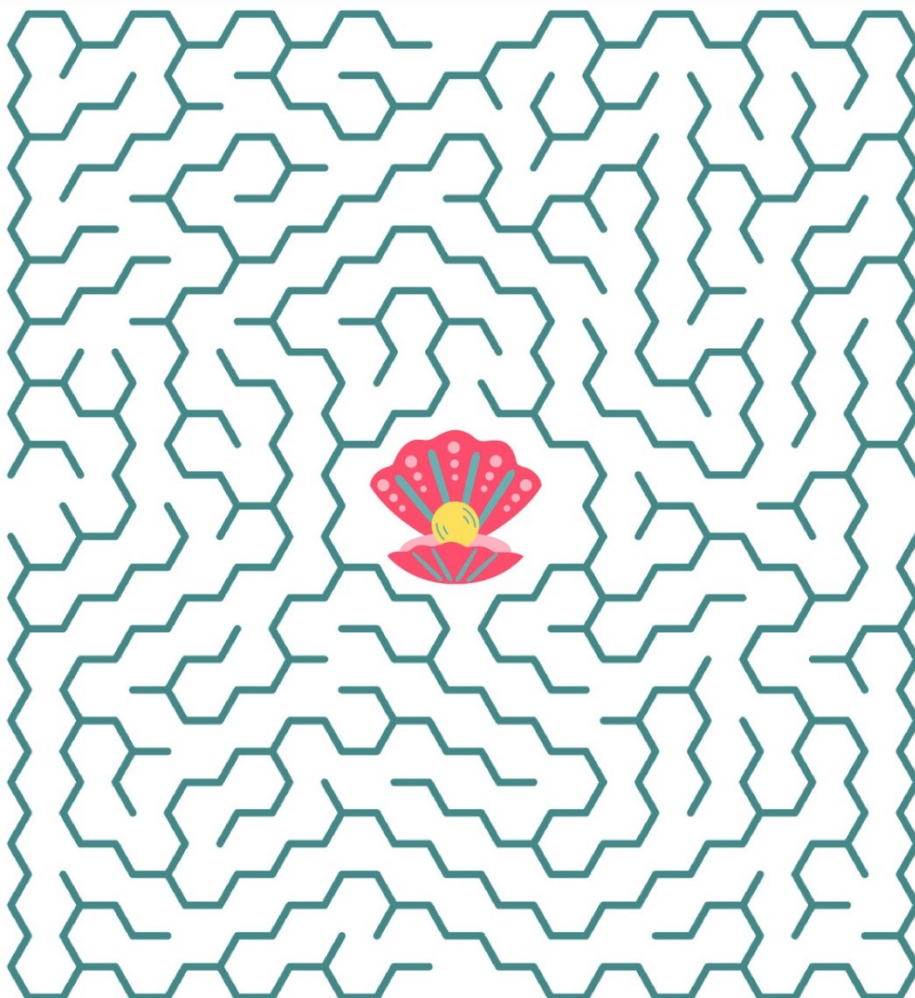

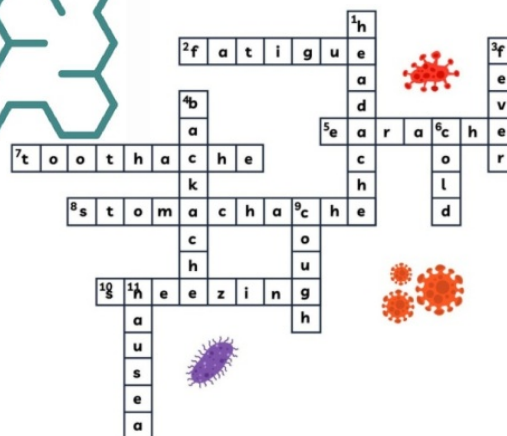
