Special Training



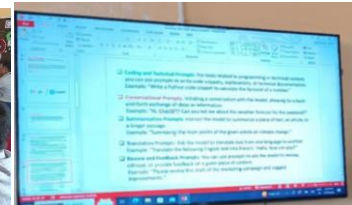
