## CONGRATULATIONS MV Volleyball Team!



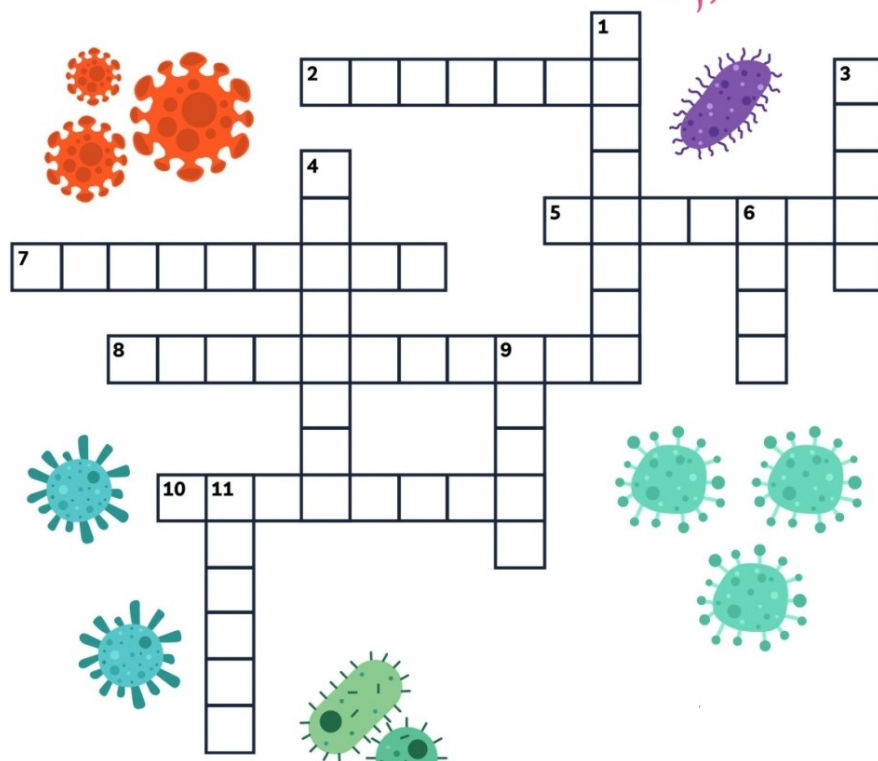
