National Space Day 2025

Our students organized a special morning assembly, fostering awareness and excitement about space science. Students from the Junior to Senior Sections actively participated in a range of activities designed to showcase their creativity and scientific understanding. A poster-making competition allowed students to express their knowledge of space and astronomy, while model-making activities featured impressive spacecraft, rockets and other space-related structures. Collage-making sessions enabled students to demonstrate their artistic interpretation of space-themed concepts. Informative videos on space exploration engaged students and enhanced their understanding of India’s achievements in the field. The celebration included an exciting quiz conducted by science teachers, testing students’ knowledge and sparking curiosity. By organizing these activities, we aim to inspire students to explore careers in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM), while emphasizing the importance of innovation, critical thinking and scientific inquiry. 79th Independence Day Celebration

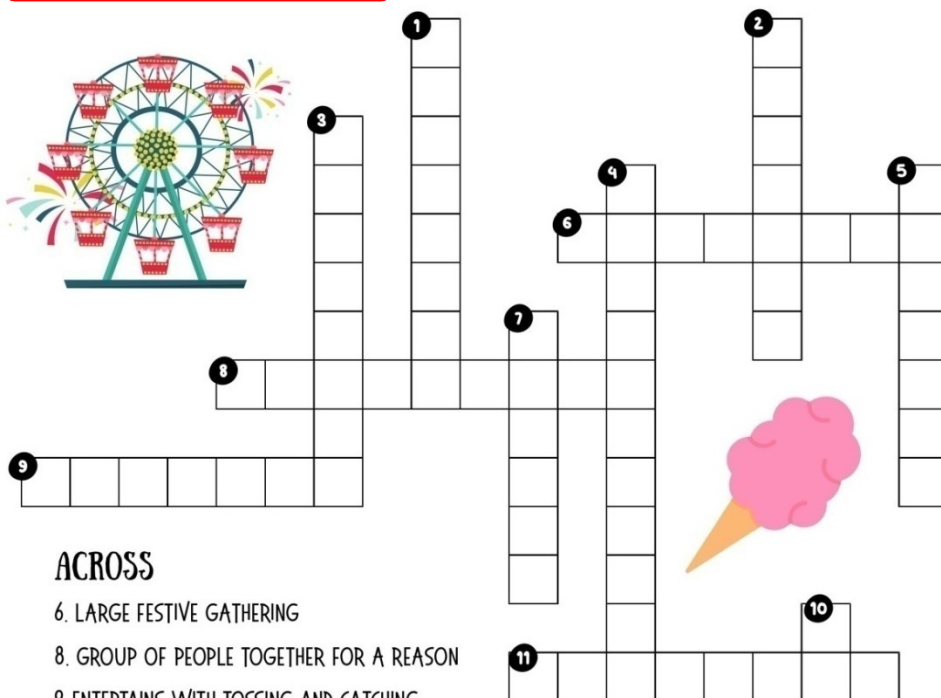

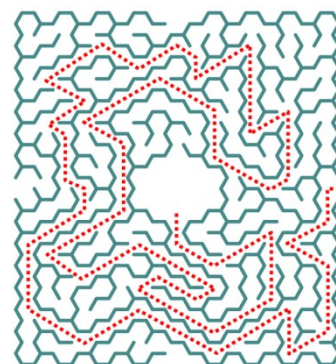
