VACCINATION DONE FOR MEASLES & RUBELLA

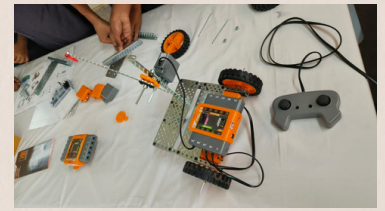
As per the directives received from the Government, a team of Doctors and Nurses from the Government Department visited our school on 29th April and 1st May 2023 for vaccination.
