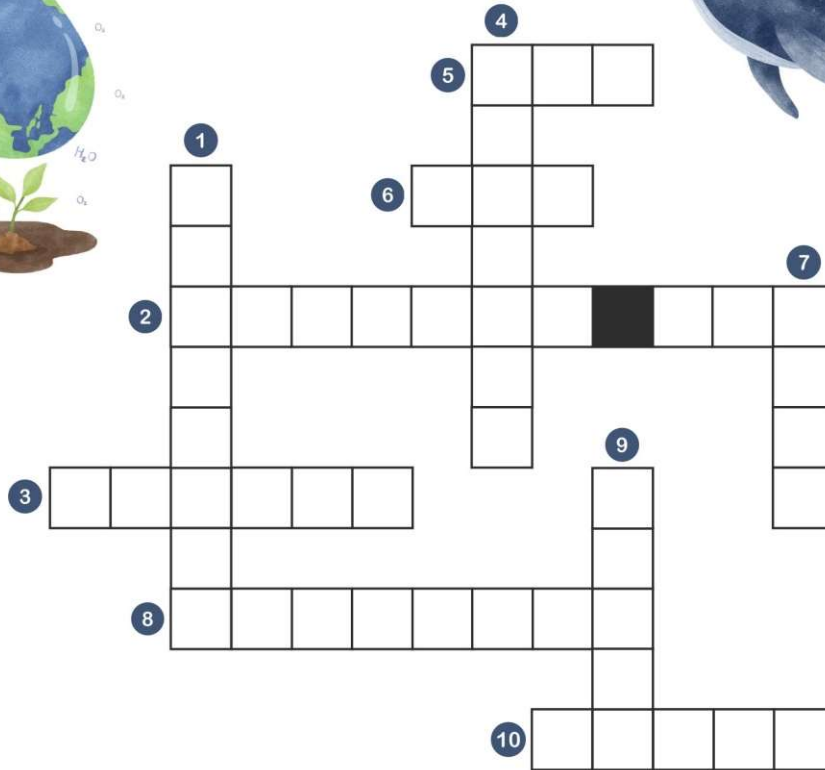

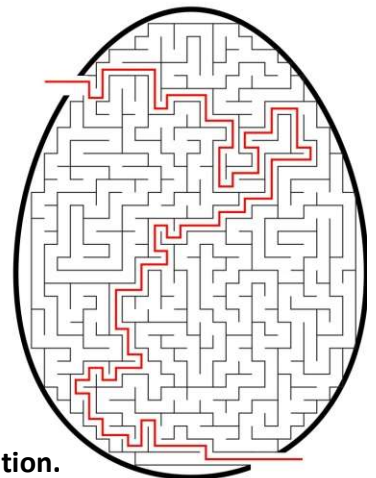
Crossword
